

# Meadow Park Slackline Area



## RULES

- Lines shall be tied only to trees designated by flagging.
- Lines shall not exceed 5 feet in height.
- Lines shall not block or cross walkways or sidewalks.
- Lines shall not be left unattended.
- Slacklining may occur only during daylight hours.

## PROTECTION AND ANCHORING STANDARDS

- Tree protection must be of sufficient thickness to protect the tree from wear damage (i.e. denim, carpet, double thickness vinyl).
- Tree protection must be at least 10" wide so that the entire anchor is protected.
- Tree protection must wrap all the way around the tree.
- Strapping material used for anchoring must be at least 1" wide.

**NOTE: SLACKLINING PERMITTED AT MEADOW PARK ONLY**

# SLACKLINING TREE PROTECTION AND ANCHORING STANDARDS\*

- Tree protection must be of sufficient thickness to protect the tree from wear damage (i.e. denim, carpet, double thickness vinyl).
- Tree protection must be at least 10" wide so that the entire anchor is protected.
- Tree protection must wrap all the way around the tree.
- Tree protection must not be attached to the anchor, so that if the anchor were to move, the bark would not be affected.
- Strapping material used for anchoring must be at least 1" wide.

**\*Note: Slacklining permitted at Meadow Park ONLY.**
