

South Street (227) Pedestrian Safety Focus Group

Terminology

Bulb-out: A traffic calming measure at an intersection that extends the sidewalks in a manner that constricts the street (width of roadway).

Consensus: Agreement reached by the group that is not unanimous, but reflects a combination of views, has majority support of the group in consideration of dissenting views and everyone can “live with it”.

MUTCD: The Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices establishes safety standards for all streets, roads and highways (applies to cities, counties and states nationwide).

Pedestrian: Generically used within the Focus Group applies to all non-motorized modes of travel (bike/pedestrian/wheelchair) and user needs (able-bodied and people with disabilities).
